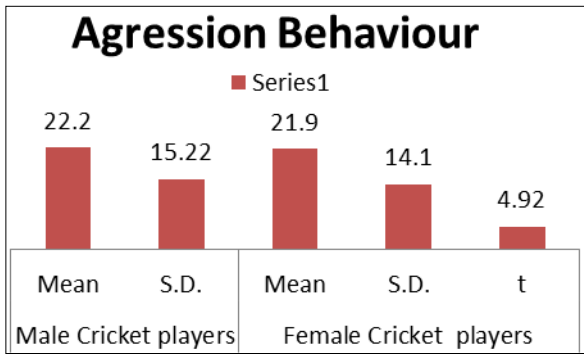


Fig 1: Graphical presentation of Aggressive Behavior between male and female Cricket players of Bhiwani district in Haryana
